

- 6 In the **Distiller Path** field, select the path where the Adobe Distiller is installed on your computer.
To browse for the location of Adobe Distiller, click the **Browse Path** button (see Figure 12-2) and navigate to the file location.

- 7 If you need to change the PostScript Directory, click that field. Then click the **Browse Path** button (see Figure 12-2) and navigate to the desired file location.
- 8 When you are finished, click **OK**.
The Setup Electronic Filing dialog box closes and your changes are saved.

► **To modify the “s/” electronic signature code for the debtor:**

- 1 From the **Setup** menu, select **Electronic Filing**.
The Setup Electronic Filing dialog box opens (refer to Figure 12-1, on page 12-3).
- 2 On the left side of the dialog box, expand the jurisdiction district folders until the desired jurisdiction division (e.g., **All**) is displayed. Then click the desired jurisdiction division.
- 3 In the **Signature Code** field, type the debtor signature code required by the jurisdiction.
- 4 Click **OK** to save your changes and close the Setup Electronic Filing dialog box.

► **To specify an electronic signature code for an attorney:**

- 1 From the **Setup** menu, select **Firm**.
The Firm Setup dialog box opens.
- 2 Click the **Representative** tab.
- 3 In the table on the right side of the dialog box, click the shaded box to the left of the attorney for whom you want to specify an electronic signature code.
- 4 Press **TAB** until the cursor is positioned in the **AttorneyESignatureCode** field. Then type the desired signature code.
- 5 Click **Close** to save your changes and close the Firm Setup dialog box.

Note: To have the specified code appear on the attorney signature line of all applicable schedules and forms for an existing case, you must first open the Voluntary Petition for the case, click the **Case Setup** tab, and reselect the designated attorney.

► **To set up Adobe Distiller:**
